


Mineral sand deposits right next door to Sunraysia Mallee Port Link and numerous others in proximity

The following maps show the close proximity of the Sunraysia Mallee Port Link rail terminal to many untouched mineral sand and rare earth strands. Iluka Resources are looking for an alternative to their bulk train loading facility at Hopetoun and instead looking to cart sands & earths in Rotainers (rotatable containers with removable lid) from pit to processing or port, which will certainly compliment the Sunraysia Mallee Port Link operations.


